

Measure 4: (Advanced Programs) Ability of Completers to Be Hired

Advanced Completer Employment

Data used to determine the ability of ECU's initial completers to be hired in the field for which the EPP prepared them include the 2019 Teacher Preparation Feedback Report from the KYSTATS website (<https://kystats.ky.gov/Reports/Reports>) and exit data from the Kentucky Graduate Assignment and Certification Inquiry Report (GACI).

Figure 4.1 contains the percentage and total number of 2017-2018 and 2019-2020 initial program completers employed within three years of completing their program. The data from these two tables come from the GACI report. The data from the report reveal that Elementary Education, Gifted Education, Literacy Specialist, and Secondary Education completers were employed at the highest rate (100%). The program with the lowest rate of employment within three years is P-12 Education.

Completers Employed in Advanced Program Area by Year 3

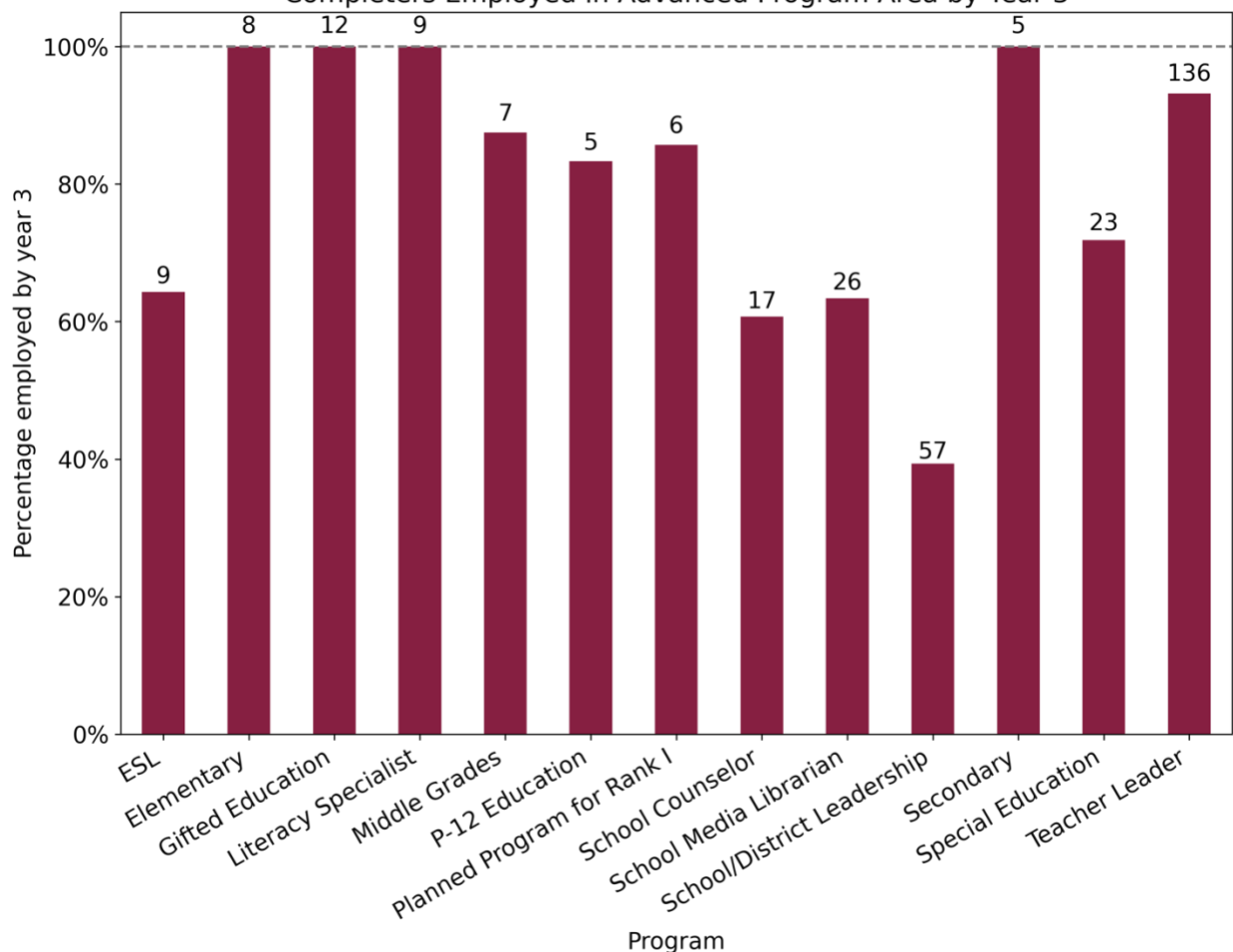


Figure 4.2 illustrates the percentage of initial completers employed in different locations and fields. The vast majority of completers are employed in Kentucky public schools.
